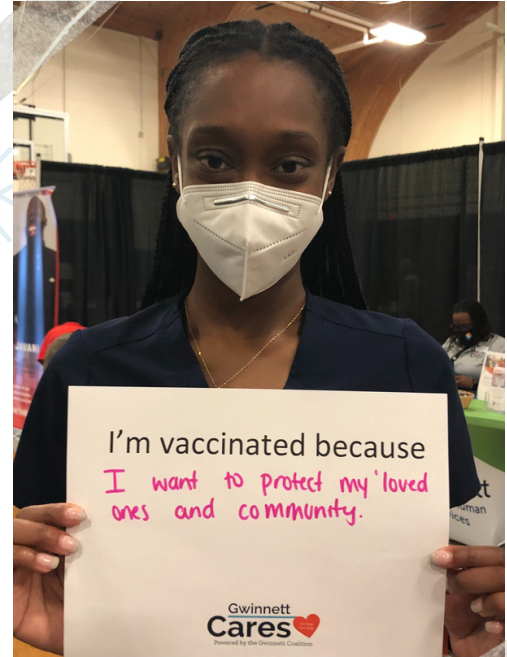

Before the COVID crisis, we were virtually unknown outside the public health and emergency response communities, even though we frequently provided support to public health for mass vaccinations, mass TB testing, hurricane evacuee shelter support, etc.

While we're currently enjoying increased awareness, this awareness will fade, along with funding, as people put the pandemic behind them. Nonetheless, we must maintain a vetted and trained volunteer force, prepared and motivated to respond to a crisis on little or no notice. I know we're thinking BIGGER than we were asked to think. But nobody gets what they don't ask for. Any endowment whose ongoing earnings could be used to help assure we remain financially viable would be helpful.

Outside of formal programming, “free computer time” is one of the most popular activities in the Program Center. Approximately 100 Villagers use the machines every week.

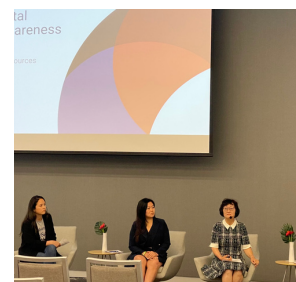

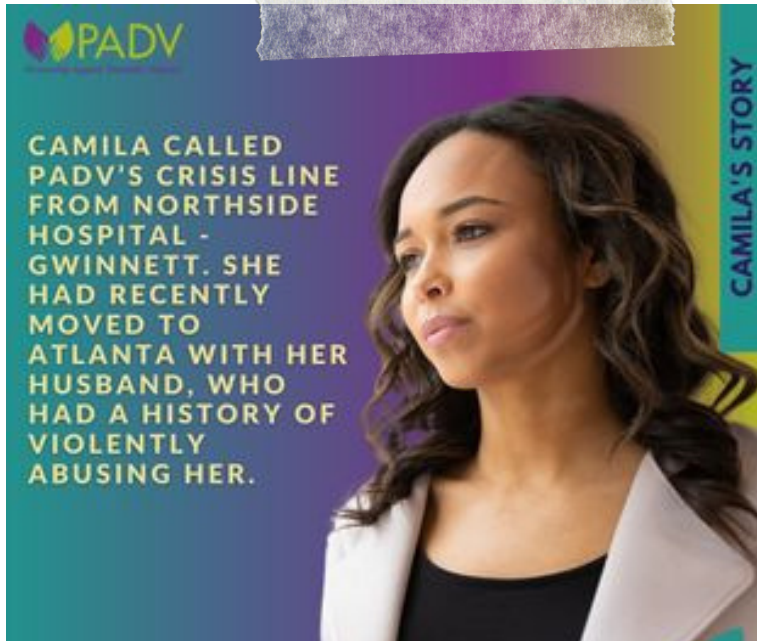

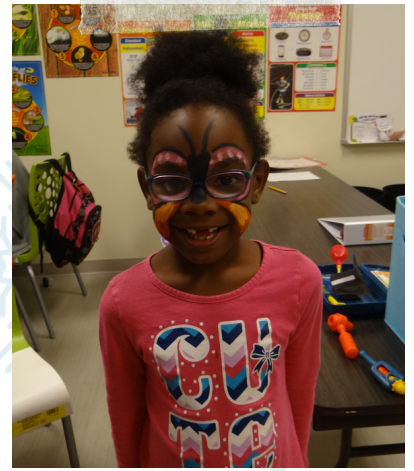
